1. Planning Application 19/01456/VARY: The Sheds.  
Mr Eastland spoke to the meeting explaining that the application involved reorientation of the building by 17 degrees to optimise photo-voltaic power generation from the solar cells mounted on the roof, and also to fit a further window into the southern façade, all to meet Passivhaus design requirements. Mr Eastland added that the window will not be seen from the track leading from the village and that the utilities and improvement of the track will be the initial activities in the development, with a practical start expected around April 20.

The Parish Council voted unanimously to forward a 'No Objections' reply to SDC. The Clerk was asked to communicate with SDC accordingly.

2. Planning Application 19/01387/FUL: The Stable Block at Stanbrook House.  
In Mrs McPherson's absence The Chairman clarified that the application includes replacement of the current internal staircase by an external staircase to the northern elevation with access to the hayloft, and the addition of simple windows to the stable to provide ventilation and light.

A unanimous vote on the application was passed by the Parish Council to lodge a 'No Objections' reply to SDC, and the Clerk was asked to communicate with SDC accordingly.
